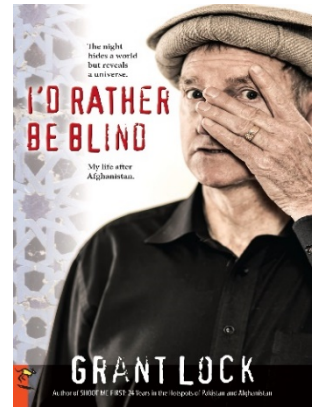

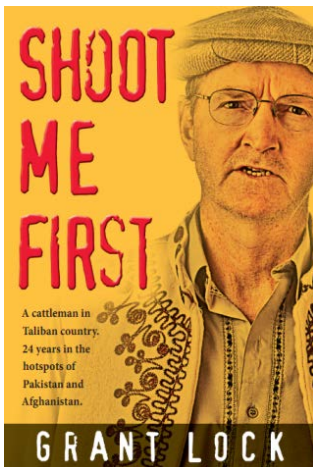


Speaking separately or together Janna and Grant’s desire is to help you to:
